

Students who are resident outside the UK may submit a digital audition with their application form via Vimeo/YouTube.

How to submit a Digital Audition to Rambert School, for September 2019 entry to the FD/BA (Hons):

1. Create a film of yourself that includes the following:
 - a. *A short introduction of yourself and why you would like to join Rambert School.*
 - b. *Barre work (approx. 10 minutes)*
 - c. *Centre work to include adage, Pirouettes and allegro (approx. 10 Minutes)*
 - d. *Centre Pointe Work (for female applicants)*
 - e. *Contemporary Solo (no longer than 3 minutes) or Sequence (no longer than 5 minutes)*
2. Upload this film to a YouTube or Vimeo account.
3. Download, complete and submit the Rambert School Application Form. Be sure to include the URL link to your video, including the password if it is a private or password-protected video.
4. Pay £50 non-refundable application fee. Preferred method of payment is by bank transfer. Please ensure you request the bank ensure the full £50 is paid to Rambert School and that any international bank charges are met by the payee.
5. Applications must be received by 1st March 2019 at 6pm. Any applications received after this will not be considered.

FAQs

I live in the UK, can I still submit a digital application?

If you are unable to attend any of the audition dates offered to you, we will consider digital auditions from UK applicants.

Can I submit a physical DVD as a digital audition?

I don't have any recent footage, can I submit old footage?

We recommend submitting footage that is as recent as possible. The digital audition will be judged only on the footage that the panel see.

Can I submit footage of me dancing in a group piece?

We will only consider digital applications that contain all elements requested in the criteria above. Your 3-minute solo may be taken from a performance, but the footage must be clear, close enough to see your face clearly and only be you dancing.
