About the course

Rambert School's Senior Summer Course offers aspiring dancers aged 15-19 years the chance to immerse themselves in dance training for one intensive week. Modelled on the timetable of the full-time FD/BA Hons degree programme, the course will be held at Rambert School's world-class purpose-built facilities in Southwest London. The course offers students the chance to study first-hand from Rambert School faculty and alumni and will culminate in a performance in the School's own Studio Theatre. This is a unique opportunity for students wishing to experience a professional training environment and prepare for auditions.

Typical day

Students will take daily ballet and contemporary technique classes, complimented by sessions in pointe, ballet repertoire, conditioning, improvisation and creative work, underpinning the School's 50/50 focus on ballet and contemporary.

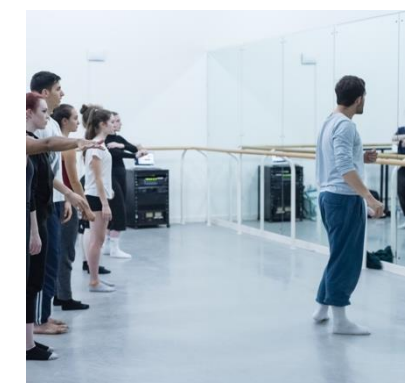
Faculty

Classes will be led by Rambert School's faculty and alumni as well as guest teachers, with technique classes accompanied by live musicians.

Requirements

Students must be at least 15 years and should not yet have turned 20 by 1st September 2019.

Students should have been attending weekly dance classes in ballet and/or contemporary dance for at least two years and be dancing at an intermediate level or above.

How to Apply

Complete and submit the online application form.

Applications will be accepted until 30th June 2019, or until all places are filled. Places will be offered to students meeting the requirements on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Payment

The course fee is to be paid in full upon acceptance of a place. Successful applicants are not confirmed a place on the course until payment has been received. If you are offered a place on the course, you will have one month from the offer date to send payment before your place is released.

A limited number of bursaries will be available to UK residents with a household income of less than £42,875. Please indicate on the application form if you are interested in applying for a bursary to receive further information.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

The course fee includes a £100 non-refundable deposit. If the place is cancelled up to one month before the start of the course, a refund of the remaining £280 will be issued. If the place is cancelled with less than one month's notice (after 29th June), no refund will be issued.
