About the course

Rambert School's Junior Summer Course is a chance for dancers aged 11-14 years to experience high-quality dance training as well as developing performance and creative skills. Designed as an opportunity for exploring ballet and contemporary techniques within a nurturing and supportive environment, the course will be held at Rambert School's world-class purpose-built facilities in Southwest London and led by Rambert School faculty, alumni, and associated artists. This is a great opportunity to expand dance experience by delving further into both ballet and contemporary dance.

Typical day

Students will take daily ballet and contemporary technique classes, complimented by sessions in ballet repertoire, conditioning and creative work, underpinning the School's 50/50 focus on ballet and contemporary.

Faculty

Classes will be led by Rambert School faculty and alumni as well as guest teachers, with technique classes accompanied by live musicians.

Requirements

Students must be at least 11 years and should not yet have turned 15 years on 1st August 2022. Students should have been attending weekly dance classes in ballet and/or contemporary dance for **at least one year**. Students do not need to be dancing en pointe to attend the course.

Applications will be accepted until 30th June 2022, or until all places are filled. Places will be offered to students meeting the requirements on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Payment

The course fee is to be paid in full upon acceptance of a place. Successful applicants are not confirmed a place on the course until payment has been received. If you are offered a place on the course, you will have one month from the offer date to send payment before your place is released.

A limited number of bursaries will be available to UK residents. Please indicate on the application form if you are interested in applying for a bursary and your household income is less than £42,875.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

The course fee includes a £100 non-refundable deposit. If the place is cancelled up to one month before the start of the course, a refund of the remaining £280 will be issued. If the place is cancelled with less than one month's notice (after 1st July), no refund will be issued.
